



Lord, we don't need another organization, There are enough organizations for everyone in the world to be a part of, Yet there are so many lonely people in the world.








It really seems that the world needs love right now. Let's see what God says about love:

Thank God "In" Everything

The upcoming Thanksgiving holiday is a time of giving thanks, where families gather with good food, fellowship, and fun. However, as Christians, every day should be a day of giving God thanks "in" and "for" everything He has done, He is doing, and what He is going to do.

We are thankful to God "for" all the good things (material) He has blessed us with and when all is going so well in our lives. But can we be thankful "in" the bad times (trials and tribulations) that come about in our lives?

As Christians, we sometimes struggle with and resist giving God thanks "in" all things, thinking that God is telling us to be thankful "in" the difficulties. However, in this thinking, we miss what He is really leading us to do. His will is for us to be thankful despite the problems and not to let disappointments, failures, losses, and hurts keep us from being thankful to Him. During challenging times, God asks us to focus on Him and His faithfulness to us rather than on our circumstances, to dwell on His promise that He would never leave nor forsake us, and to trust Him to help us in every situation we face in life.

We can thank God "in" all things, even when we don't understand why He allows certain things to happen. The Bible tells us that God is good and faithful and has a plan and a purpose "in" everything He does. When we thank God "in" all things, we acknowledge His goodness and faithfulness, expressing our dependence on Him. As we depend on God, He will give us what we need to endure and persevere (wisdom, strength, comfort, hope, joy, peace). We must realize that "in" all things, we are more than conquerors through Christ Jesus (Romans 8:37).

Thanking God "in" all things is not easy, but it is possible by the power of the Holy Spirit who lives in us. He helps us to see things from God's perspective and to remember His promises and faithfulness. He also fills our hearts with peace and joy as we experience His presence and grace. Thanking God "in" all things also helps us to have a positive and joyful attitude and to overcome worry and anxiety. It also strengthens our relationship with Him as we draw near to Him with gratitude and praise.

Meditate on the following scriptures:

- Philippians 4:6-7 "Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus."
- Philippians 4:11-13 "Not that I speak in regard to need, for I have learned in whatever state I am, to be content: I know how to be abased, and I know how to abound. Everywhere and in all things I have learned both to be full and to be hungry, both to abound and to suffer need. I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me."
- **Colossians 4:2** "Continue steadfastly in prayer, being watchful in it with thanksgiving.

God is sovereign and still in control of all things; nothing can happen without His permission or knowledge. So, we can trust that He knows what is best for us. He will use everything for our good and His glory as we keep our minds and hearts stayed on Him, following His leading. Thank God "in" Everything!
